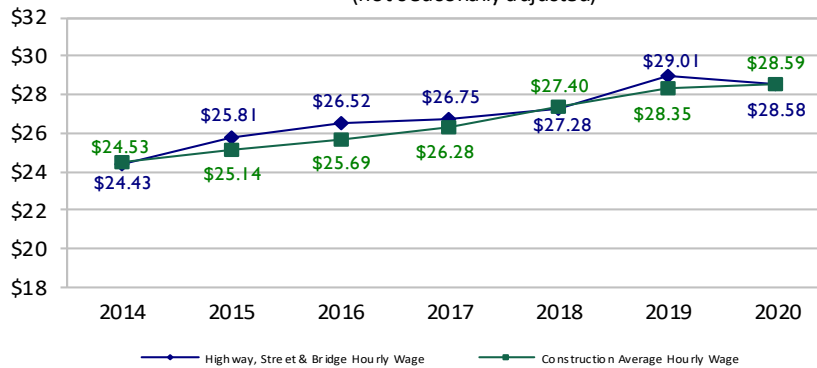
**Transportation Construction Employment Fell in April 2020**

There were 324,300 workers employed by highway and bridge contractors in April. Employment in highway and bridge construction fell by 3.9 percent in April 2020 compared to April 2019, a decrease of about 13,300 workers.

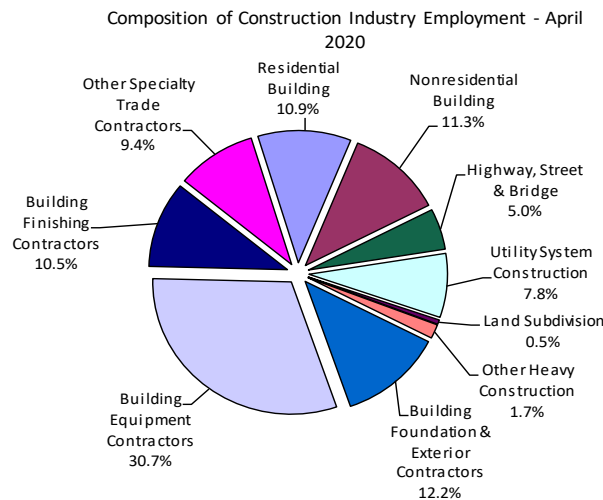
Average April Hourly Wage of Production Workers in Highway, Street & Bridge Construction vs. All Construction (not seasonally adjusted)
